The author does a great job of reintroducing them at the beginning of the book, but someone who isn't familiar with the previous books will still be completely lost. What I liked: Everything you've come to expect from one of Gini Koch's Alien books: Lots of humor, snark and action, a convoluted plot, evil masterminds, strong women, handsome men, and lots of poofs. If you've read the previous books in the series, you'll enjoy this book, too. What I didn't like: 1) My first instinct was to write 'too many characters', but then I remembered that I felt that way about all the Alien books, and I still keep buying them. So, I guess I shouldn't complain, but I do wish there was a list of characters somewhere in the book. It would simplify matters immensely, especially for those of us who have trouble recalling names under the best of circumstances. 2) There's definitely some progress in the overall story arc of the series, but I wish there was a little more innovation. In previous installments, we were introduced to monsters, aliens, god-like entities, clones, androids, and a slew of other things. There was nothing fundamentally new in this book. In a few places, I got the feeling that this is sort of a transitional book, moving us from one story arc to the next. That's not in itself a bad thing, but I missed the crazy plot twists of the earlier books. Conclusion: A great book for fans of the series. I'm very much looking forward to the next book, 'Universal Alien', due out in December 2014.
