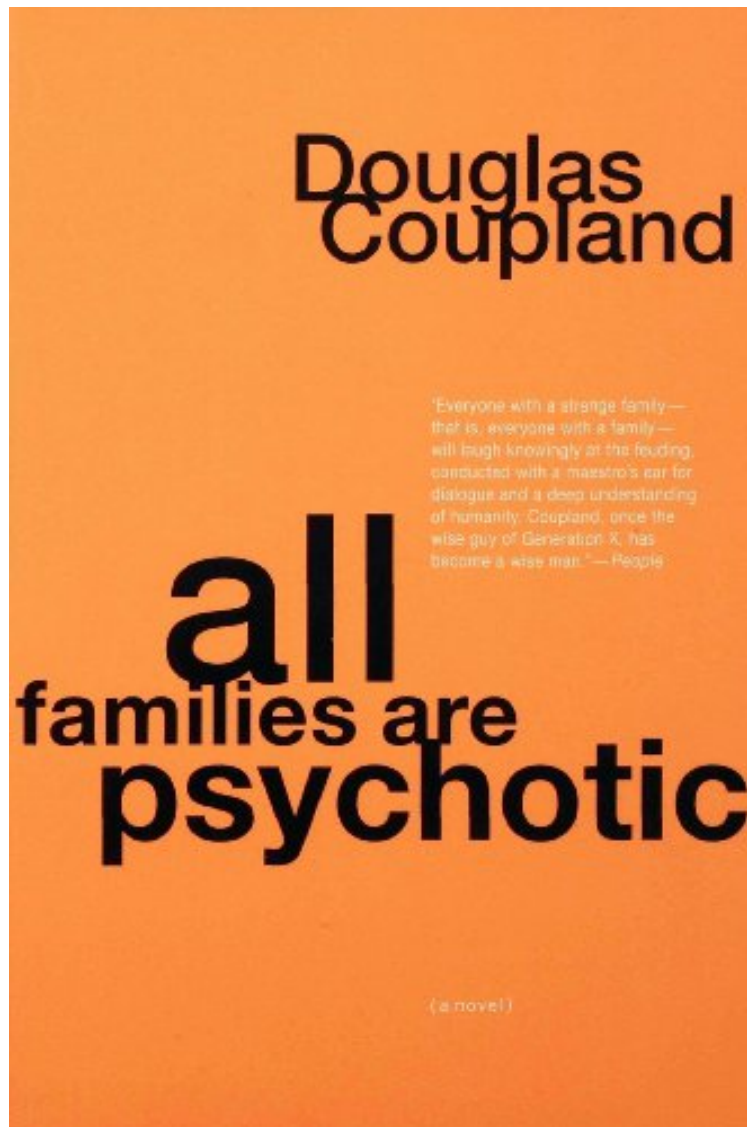

It is an interesting Douglas Coupland topic: life the hard way mixed with fairy tale elements. Don't get me wrong, I really appreciate, that he is one of the few authors who really dare to write fiction! Family, parents middleaged and divorced because hubby found new trophy wife. All are waiting for the launching of the rocket.. the atmosphere is tense, members of this family are sick in various stages of AIDS and Cancer.
