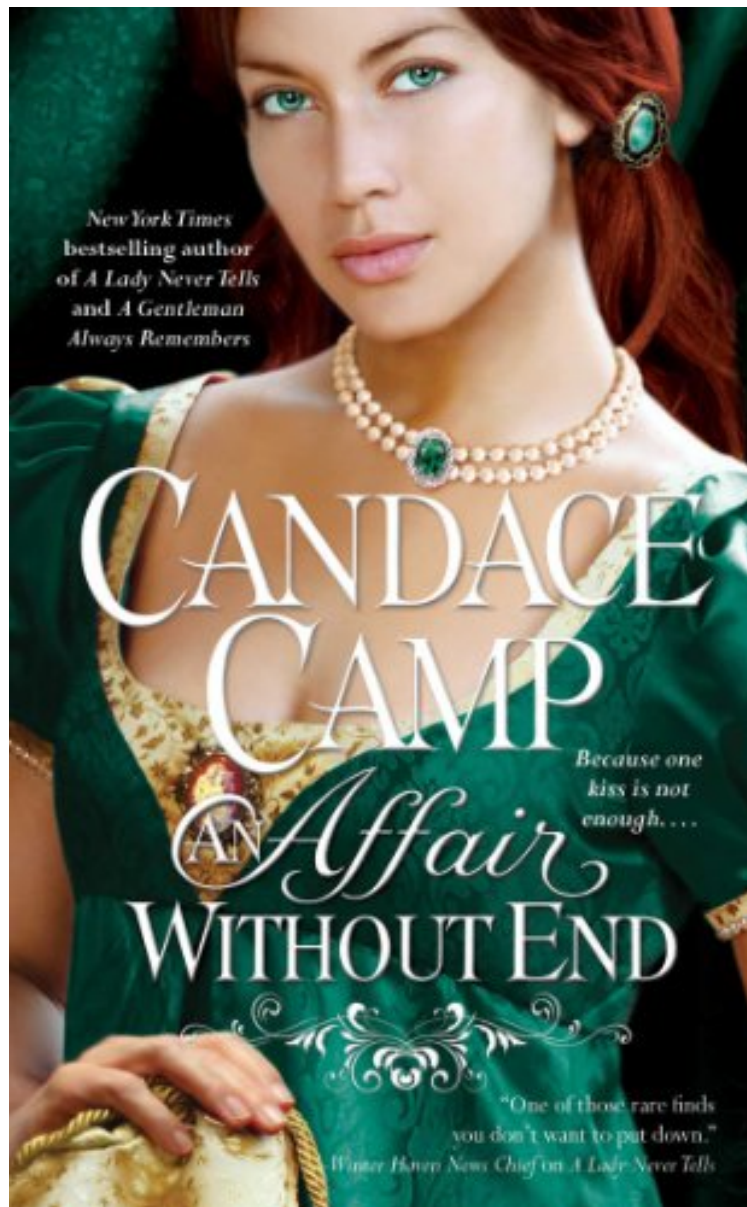

So interessant die Geschichte in der Zusammenfassung klingt, so enttäuschend war das Buch. Es gibt keinerlei Spannung, kein Knistern und nicht mal besonders interessante Charaktere. Von Anfang an ist klar wie die Geschichte enden wird, genau wie die kleine Nebengeschichte, die in das Buch eingebaut ist. Es gibt keinerlei Höhepunkte.
