have been easy to portray him as evil incarnate, a one-dimensional testosterone monster bent on raping and dominating all that is female and free and wholesome and good. But I don't get the impression that he's an unusually bad sort of guy, as guys go. Rather, Forrest makes him a real, 3-D person with real feelings and real motivations, and in so doing is able to make a powerful point about the disastrous effects of socially-constructed gender roles on otherwise reasonable people.
