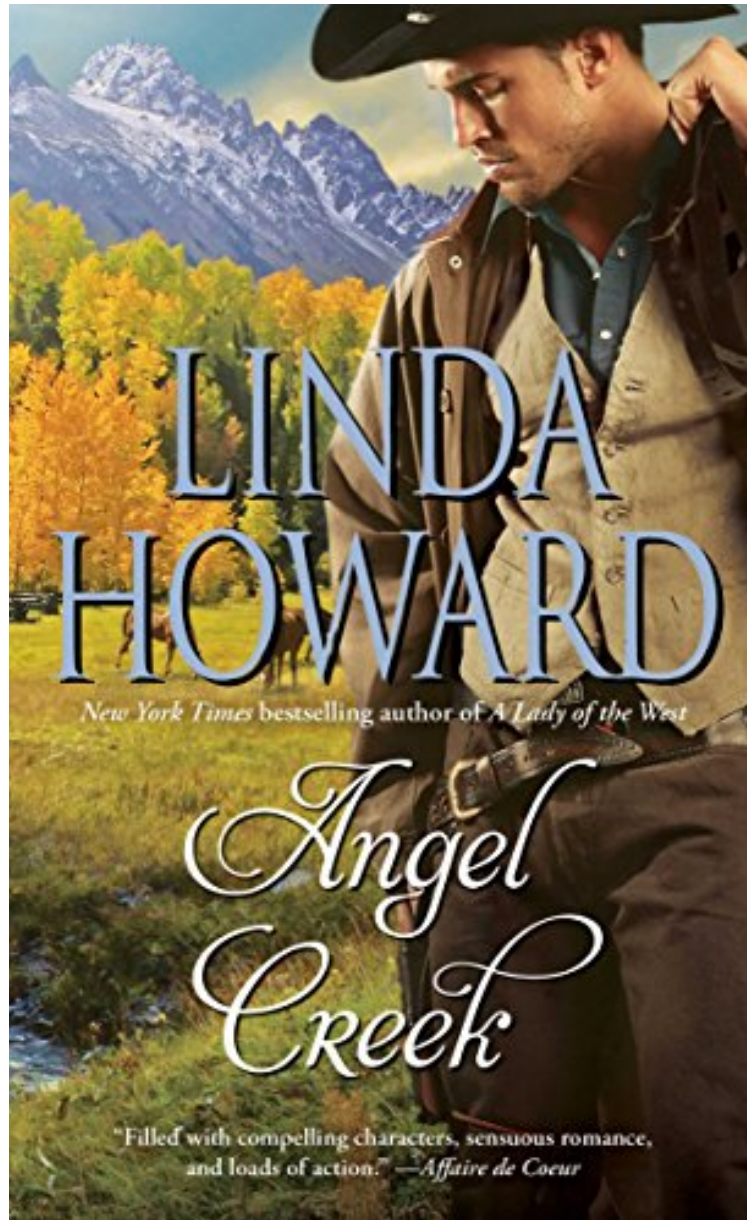

Aside from that, I found this book long and torturous. It was nothing at all like A Lady of the West, which was action packed and plot turning and twisting. Angel Creek was slow to burn and fleeting in flame. I was very disappointed. The fact that the hero was only after sex from the beginning on didn't help to polish him over either. This seems to be a recurring theme with all of Howard's heroes (since I am also reading "Heart of Fire" too). Personally, I'm just not sold on that idea, that the man's focus gets turned onto wanting this one woman so much, it's become a distraction to even the reader. In this sense, Howard is beginning to sound a lot like Julie Garwood, where it's if you've read one, you've read them all. The setting may be different but the stories become predictable and redundant of each other. I hope that Midnight Rainbow and Heart of Fire will prove it otherwise.
