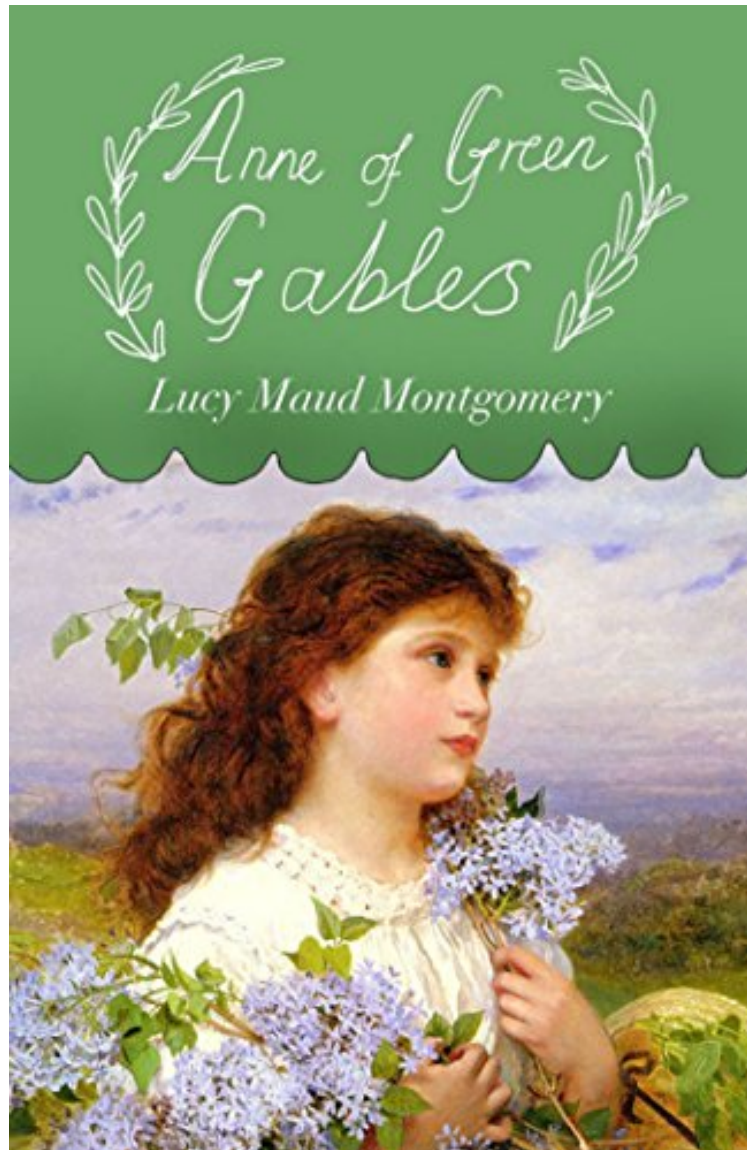

Angefangen mit dem liebevoll ausgewählten Millais-Bild auf dem Schutzumschlag, das Anne ganz treffend darstellt, obwohl es sich bei dem Mädchen gar nicht um sie handelt, bis hin zur illustrierten Fußnote über auch noch die kleinste Pflanze am Wegesrand in Avonlea, die im Text erwähnt wird: nicht nur die Inspirationsquellen der Figuren und Orte sind minutis recherchiert. Auch Bibelzitate, Ausschnitte aus Gedichten und Kochrezepte, bis hin zu Kleiderschnitten wird hier alles erklärt, was es für den heutigen Leser zu erklären gilt. Manchmal sind sogar Dinge erklärt, die jedem halbwegs gebildeten Leser selbstverständlich erscheinen, die aber vielleicht in einigen Jahrzehnten schon einer Erklärung bedürfen. Einige Interpretationsansätze der Autoren halte ich für fragwürdig, aber dennoch ist es durchaus faszinierend, was die verschiedenen Literaturwissenschaftler zu der klassischen Kinderfigur zu sagen haben. Wer also des Englischen gut genug mächtig ist, um die Originaltexte zu lesen - der erste Anne-Band ist ja hier im Original abgedruckt - der sollte sich dieses ausführliche Kompendium mit vielen Photos der Originalschauplätzen, Personen und sogar der Inspiration zur Figur der Anne nicht entgehen lassen! 1 von 1 Kunden fanden die folgende Rezension hilfreich. Through a series of mishaps, the person who ends up under their roof is a precocious girl of eleven named Anne Shirley. Anne is bright and quick, eager to please but dissatisfied with her name, her pale countenance dotted with freckles, and with her long braids of red hair. Being a child of imagination, however, Anne takes much joy in life, and adapts quickly, thriving in the environment of Prince Edward Island. From Kirkus s Anne certainly merits the comprehensive, scholarly study demonstrated in the annotated margins, footnotes, critical essays, asides, and appendixes that accompany the original text of Anne of Green Gables. Between these covers lies an entire academic course, covering the kinds of biographical, geographical, literary, and mythological allusions that a good professor would explicate--e.g., that one of Anne's compositions may have been inspired by ideas or phrases in the works of Elizabeth Barrett Browning or George Eliot--but also including colloquial terms, foods, fabrics, plants, expressions, songs, and poetry of Anne's time, and information about Montgomery as well. Annotations accompany the text of the novel explaining references to people, places, literary works, quotations, events, flora, fauna, etc. within the narrative. The volume is filled with illustrations from different editions of Anne and photos of Montgomery, her handwritten manuscript, her childhood home, her school, her parents and family, Prince Edward Island, plants, pictures of the times, and more. One section explains the variants among different editions of the work. The appendix includes the geography of the island and Cavendish, the author's childhood home upon which she based Avonlea. Also included are scholarly essays on the history of the Celtic settlers on Prince Edward Island, orphanages and children, education, gardens and plants, home life, food preparation and cookery (including contemporary recipes), music and elocution, and literary allusion and quotations in Anne of Green Gables.
