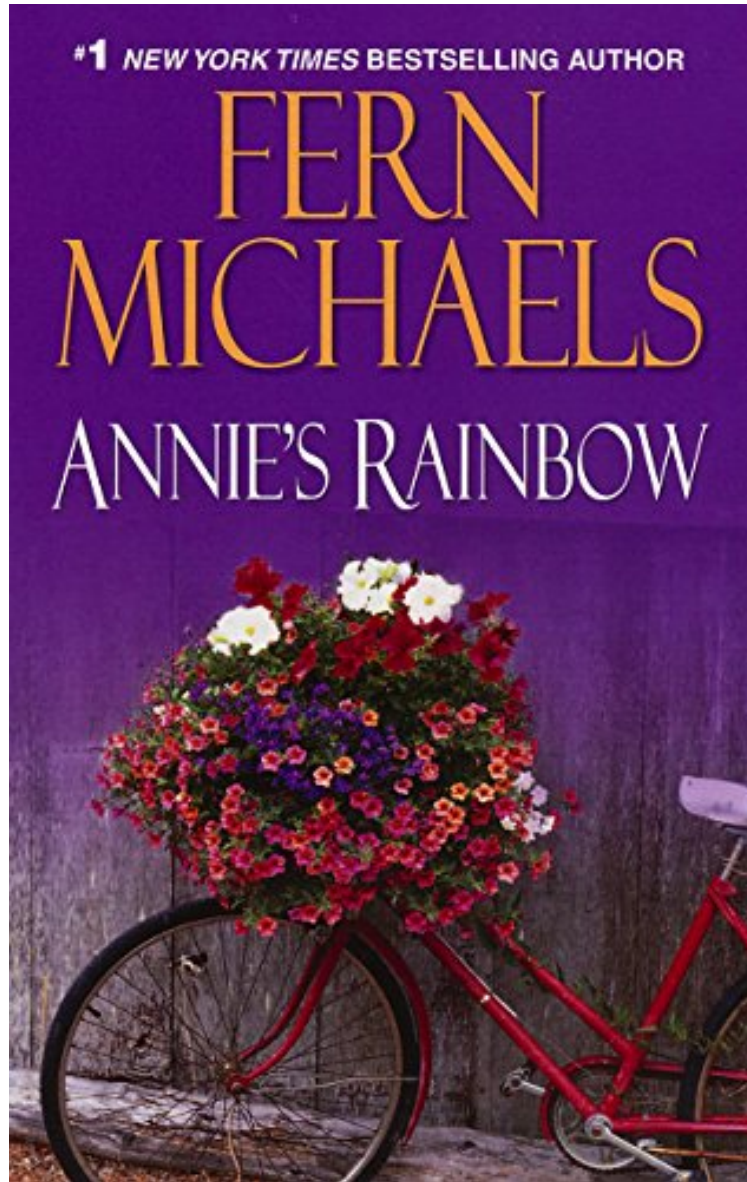

Ultimately, Annie secretly returns the cash with interest, but it is still not over as one of the convicted robbers plans revenge for his lingering behind bars.

ANNIE'S RAINBOW is a well-written contemporary woman's fiction that reads like a biography of one strong female. The story line moves forward, though the ending seems a bit contrived. Annie is a wonderful character, but seems too perfect even with her flaws.
