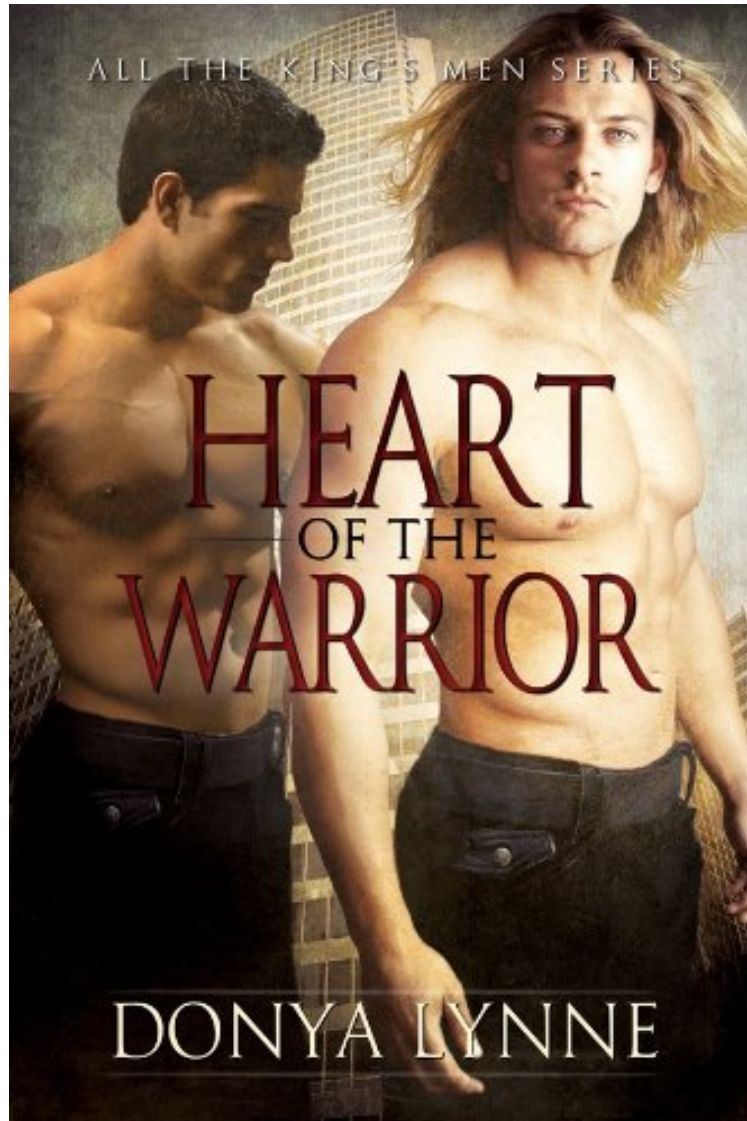

This story was for me a real improvement in comparison to the other two and worth the read of the others. First of all I am not into books with gay sexual relationships. Not that they disturb me but they simply don't excite me. It was the same in this book and there are a lot of sexual scenes here.
