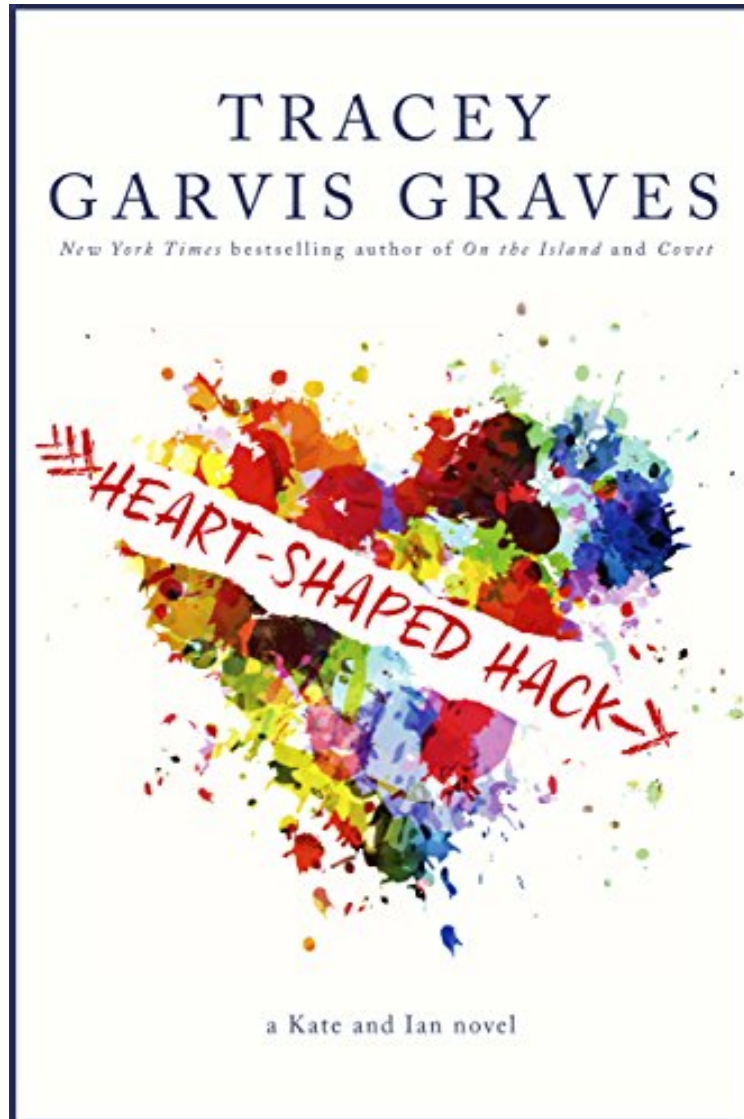

He doesn't have any friends or anyone he is really close with. He has had girlfriends in the past, but because of what he does he moves around a lot and they are not always willing to come with him. The problem I had with the story was the writing. It was overly descriptive, which I don't like, and also a lot of the conversations are a bit clinical. At times their conversations were fun and they made me laugh, but overall not so much. Everything just felt a bit disconnected for me so I couldn't get into the story. It became very apparent that I wasn't connecting with the characters when something happens to disrupt their little happy bubble, something that should have been really heartbreaking and upsetting, and I was just eh on it.
