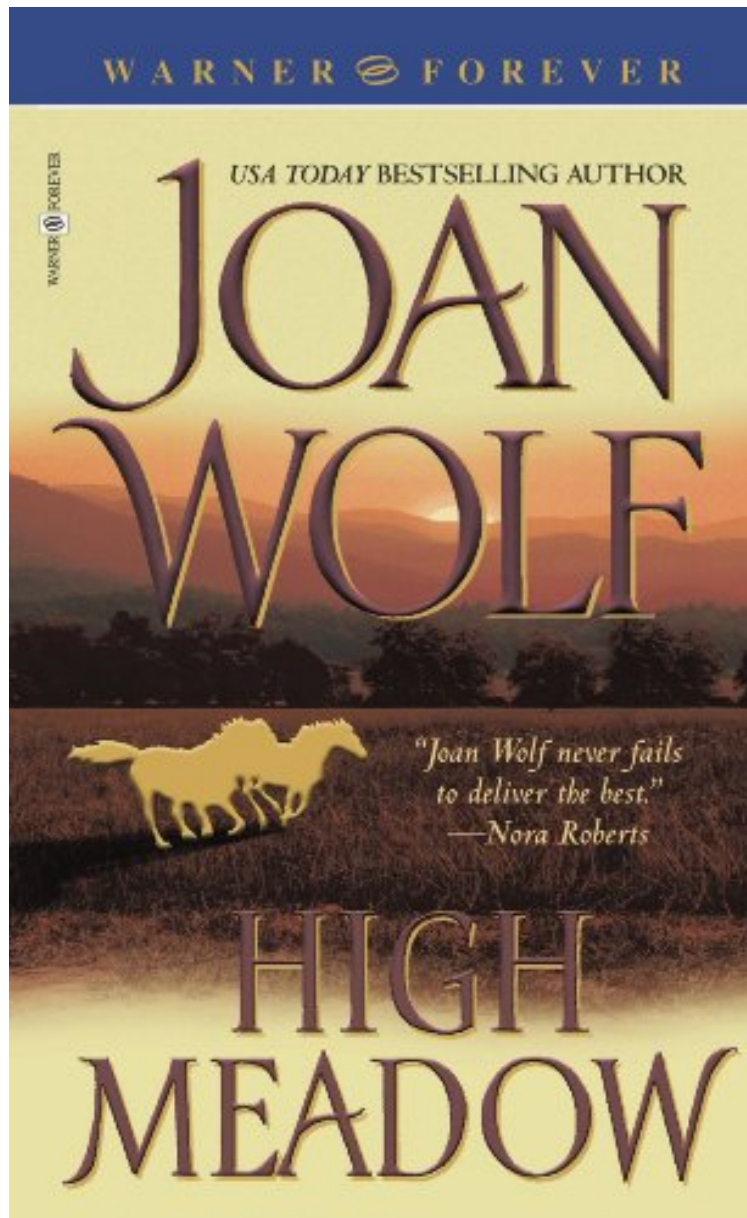

charm of her regency novels, characters acting as 'normal' persons (this means they are NOT doing totally inappropriate things for that, (which most characters in romance novels normally do, they are usually totally overrun by their emotions) - and even paying a little attention to the political background of that time) is not charming in a contemporary. Instead of real people you get the feeling, that especially Kate (the heroine of this piece), is a cold person; she is a little bit one-dimensional, only focused on her horses and her family. The character of the baseball pro Daniel is better drawn (at the end he behaves very macho and illogical, but that is, as I assume, human). The story: When Daniel discovers that he has a son, Ben, that lives with his aunt Kate (who acts as his mother; because Ben's mother, her sister is dead), Daniel strives to be a part of his son's life. At first Kate is not at all happy about Daniel taking part in their lives, but as time goes by Daniel and Kate .... you can imagine the rest. All in all I liked *High Meadow*, it was a nice and even interesting read, but Ms Wolf's former efforts were much better. I recommend them, especially *the Arrangement*.
