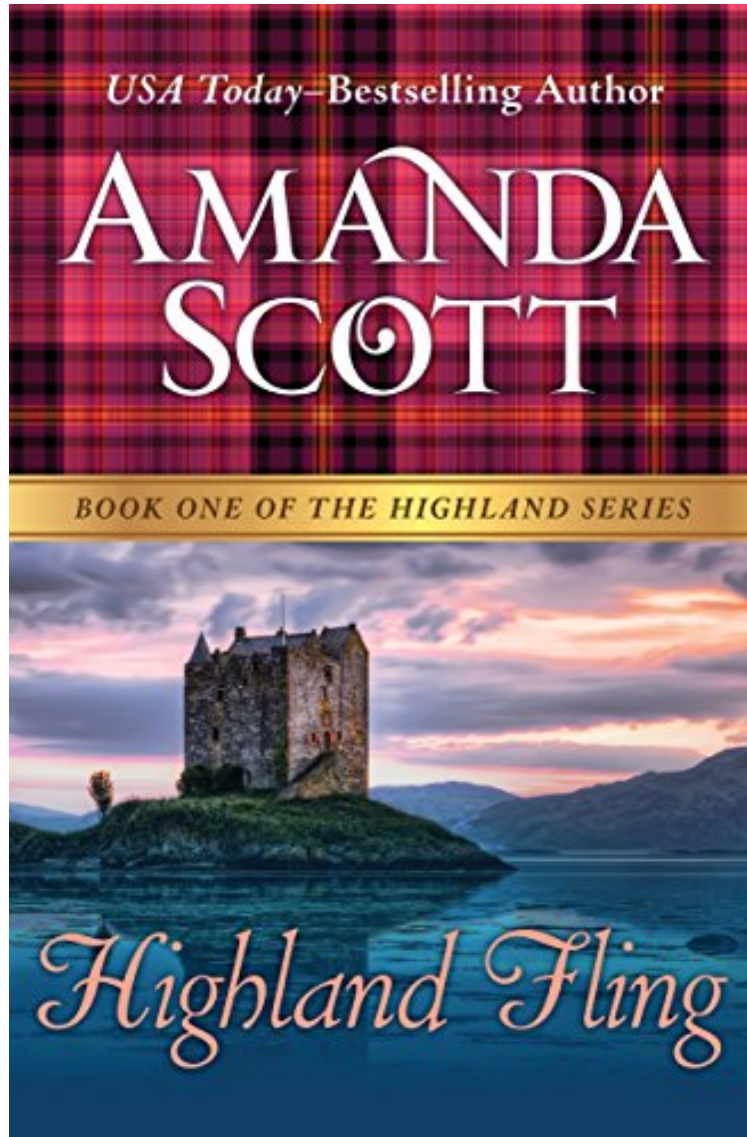

Almost all the characters are slighty "overdone": the old Highland Lord is sooo witty, the British owner is sooo understanding of the Highlands' difficulties, the bailiff is sooo bad, the whiskey sooo good, the heroine sooo cute

and impulsive, her girlfriend sooo dangerous, the British stepmother sooo ambitious, the British half-brother sooo independent and strong-headed (but can't get through to his own mother) etc. But still, it is nice to read with lots of funny situations and action. The characters are easy to get along with, feel with them, laugh or scoff with them. The historical parts read well researched, no sneers are truly blatant mistakes or inconsistencies needed. The mystery part does catch your interest. Of course you'd rather want to suspend too much sense of realism - this isn't a history book, nor does it claim to be.For a novel, it manages well to take you back, hold your interest and make you like the protagonists. If that's what you're looking for, 'Highland Fling' may be right up your alley. It was for me. There is one point of critique I have though, and that is the rather abrupt ending. I don't feel fully satisfied with the way the story breaks off, to me: unfinished. There are quite a few loose endings, and when I turned the last page, seeing some author's notes I wondered why anybody would interrupt the flow of a novel with historical references as I've seen it done in chapter wise released fanfiction works in progress...! Then I realized the book was finished and thought, drat, a series, will have to go buy the next part. Only to find out that, while this being called 'The Highland Series', the other books do not employ the same protagonists in a leading role, but are rather stand-alone novels in the same place and time setting. And now I feel a bit dissatisfied. So, one star deduction for that.
