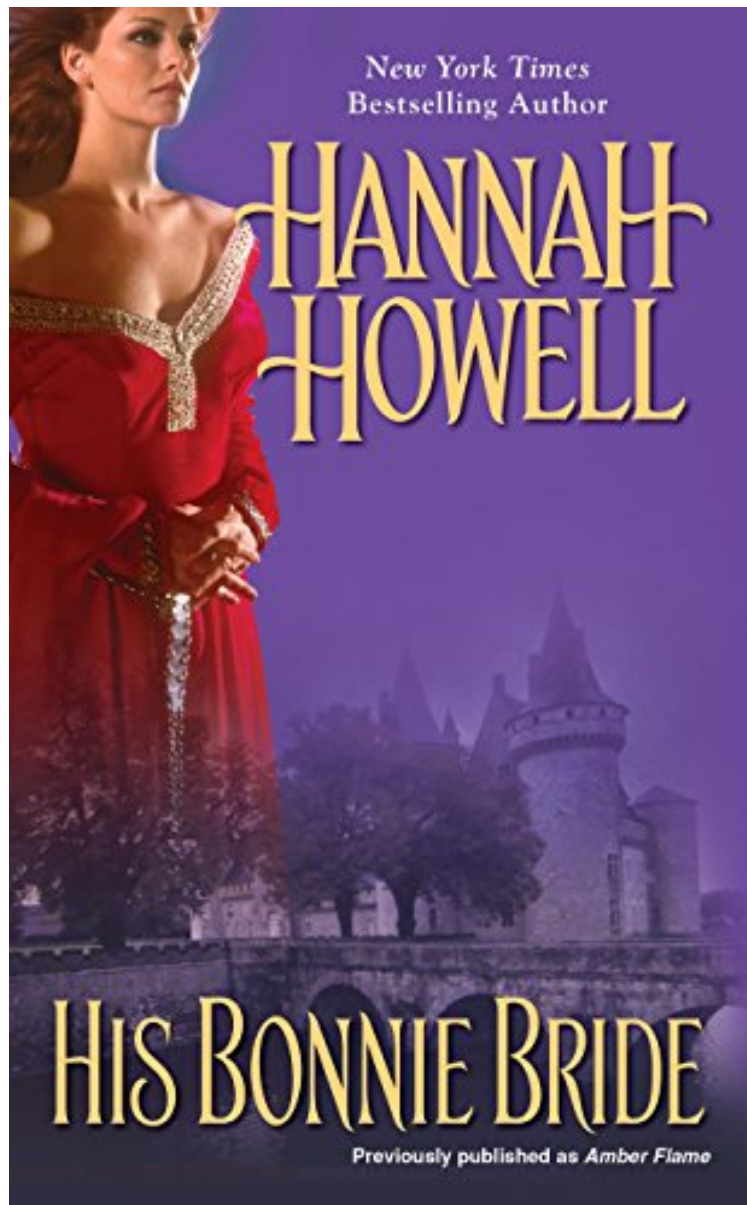

terrible. Maybe it's because I've read Diana Gabaldon before, but "His Bonnie Bride" is just so boring. The characters are lifeless, there is not one bit of humor in the whole book and apart from that it is really unrealistic altogether. Everyone falls for Storm (sorry, nobody would have called their kid Storm in 13xx, all men want her but are gentle and thoughtful and do not touch her in situations where in reality she just would have been raped and killed. Apart from that the language is more than simple and repeats itself over and over (mayhaps mayhaps mayhaps...) and all the situations seem so very invented and staged it wasn't possible for me to imagine only one character of this book for real. I know, Gabaldon's story with the magic stones isn't for real as well, but at least she manages to bring those characters to life, to make you laugh with them or feel sad with them and so on.
