Even though her parents want the best for her, the cost of college, at least the college she hopes to attend, is not

something they can afford. Then a job with an amazing paycheck becomes available. Amy is going to babysit. Her charge's name is Tristan, but there's a catch. Tristan is about to graduate from high school just like Amy. The reason he needs a sitter is because he is blind. A horse jumping accident combined with an inherited condition involving weakened retinas have left Tristan without his sight. His mother hires Amy with the hope that someone his age can convince him to take the steps necessary to resume a more normal life. Once Amy begins hanging out with Tristan, she learns that things are more complicated than just his loss of sight. He is also grieving the sudden death of his father and the guilt that their relationship was not at its best. Amy has her own family struggles. She tells Tristan about her mother's eccentric behavior of fixing family meals to include a son who left home ten years ago. Although the job pays extremely well, Amy begins to realize money isn't the only thing that keeps her coming back. As Tristan begins to make small gains in adjusting to his new life, a relationship develops that goes beyond employer/employee. Since their lifestyles are completely different, Amy hesitates to get too close, but soon it just might be beyond her control.

HIS EYES is the first novel for Renee Carter. Readers will sense the chemistry between Amy and Tristan immediately. Carter fills out her cast of characters with family members such as Tristan's funny younger brother and cute little sister and an annoyingly self-centered ex-girlfriend named Lexus. Although at times predictable, HIS EYES offers a fast-paced read for readers looking for a bit of romance.

Young 17 year old Amy has been accepted in two different universities to follow her dream of wanting to become a journalist. But the more expensive one is too expensive for her... When she gets the opportunity to earn a lot of money by "baby-sitting a young man her age, Tristan who had a riding accident and has lost his sight, she does not hesitate and accepts, he however is more reluctant and takes time to accept her. At first their relation is very distant, even if she seems to try, but it gets hotter fast. His eyes are a nice young adult love story of two very different persons. But still I had trouble with some parts of the book. First of all I did not like the black and white drawing of his and her world (very rich vs. poor; very happy family vs. Family which had some tragic events in their life...). The main complication after they get along in only some days (definitely not enough time to really get to know each other) is Tristan's (ex) girlfriend. Here once again I had a real problem with the extreme caricaturisation of her. The other trouble I have is the lack of in depth characterisation of Amy and Tristan, but also of their parents, his small brother is great however. The speed at which the story went by, the real fast end... all this left me hungry. The story is nice, but something is missing. Great potential, weak execution, but in this case I enjoy imagining what could have been written. This is Renee Carter's first book, it dates from Aug 2009. I have not seen any other book by her, which is sad because she has potential. Enjoy the read MBTM
