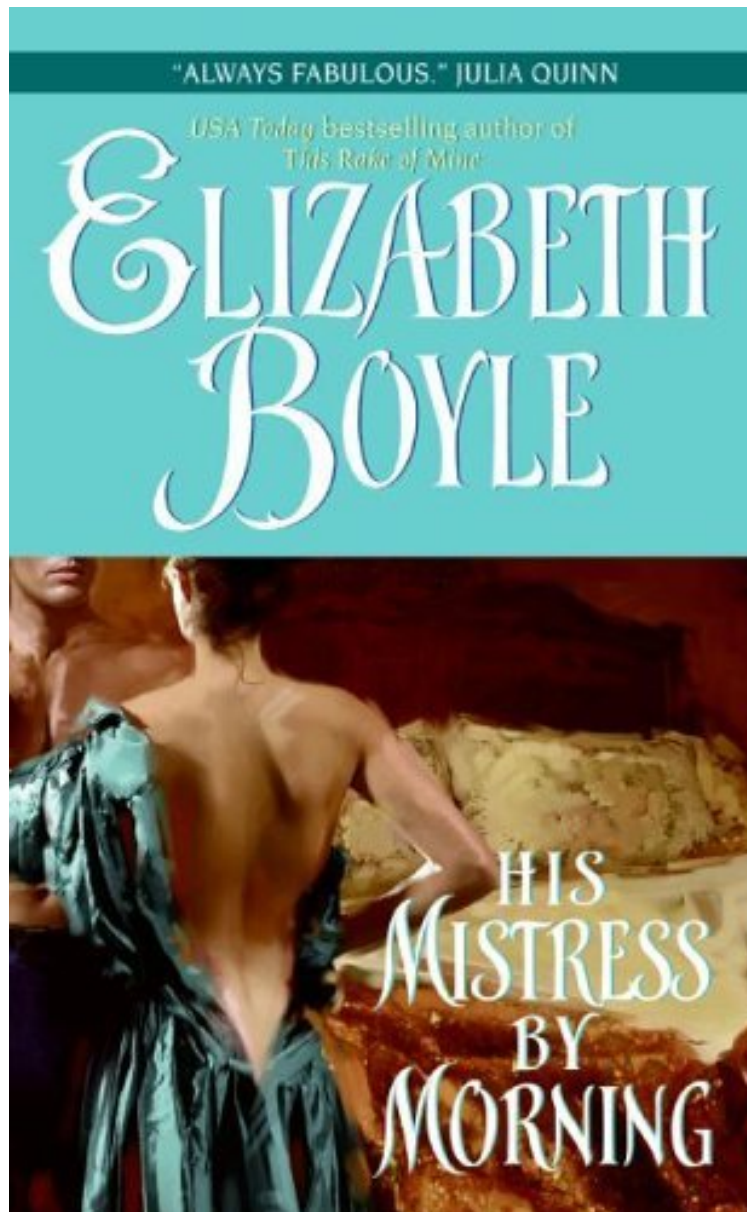

Sie machen die Dinge an den entscheidenden Stellen regelmäßig zu einfach. Ich mag auch nicht die allzu einfache "Moral von der Geschichte": es ist deine eigene Herangehensweise an die Dinge, die den Lauf der Dinge bestimmt. Da ist zwar was wahres dran und es ist nicht ganz falsch, aber es ist als Patentlösung zu einfach. Trotzdem, dieses Buch hat magische Momente, die es lesenswert machen: Charlotte Wilmont ist dabei, eine sehr unscheinbare alte Jungfer zu werden und hoffnungslos in Lord Sebastian Trent verliebt, den Bruder ihrer besten Freundin Hermione. Sie muss zusehen, wie dieser der verhassten Lavinia Burke den Hof macht, weil er sich angesichts desaströser Familienfinanzen und dreier unverheirateter Schwestern verpflichtet sieht, in erster Linie nach Geld zu heiraten. Charlotte wünscht sich nichts mehr, als da sie die Auserwählte wäre, aber Sebastian scheint sie nicht einmal wahrzunehmen. Dann, eines Morgens, geht ihr Wunsch scheinbar in Erfüllung. Sie wacht als Kurtisane Lottie mit Sebastian neben sich auf. Aber auch dieses Leben entpuppt sich als nicht ganz das Gelbe vom Ei...
