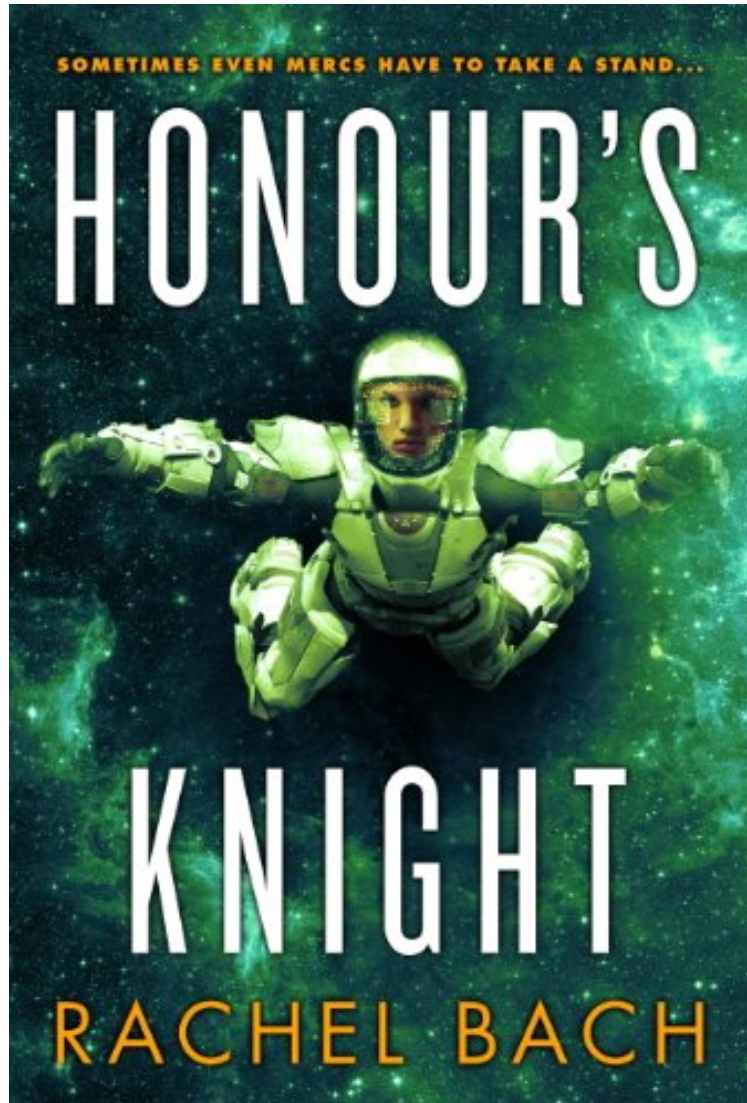

Anyway, this review will

inevitably contain spoilers for events in book one. Review Honour's Knight starts where Fortune's Pawn broke off: Devi works on the Glorious Fool, the unfortunate merchant spaceship, as a security officer. After she got her mind wiped by Rupert the alien-symbiont/warrior/cook to save her from being killed [for knowing too much, no less], she doesn't know any more about her feelings for Rupert, the symbionts and the true purpose of the Glorious Fool. But as in book one, Devi inadvertently gets into trouble and stumbles upon truths, so even with a wiped brain, she isn't safe for long and the situations she finds herself in get worse by the minute. And the really good thing about this adventure is that a lot of stuff happens that I did not see coming. The same goes for the never ending series of revelations: at the end of the book, nothing is as it was before and it's safe to say that Devi's world is thoroughly turned upside down. Her character stays her cool self and I admire her no-nonsense kind of thinking and acting. She is a bit like a Klingon from Star Trek, easy to be enraged, easy to be affected and inclined to start a fight at the least provocation. But at the same time, she feels very real, because she has a lot of honor and an honest to god hero's complex but then she doesn't want to die if she can prevent it and if it's her or anyone else, she is prone to choosing herself. She is a good person, but not an angel and yes, she is a merc and hired herself out to kill other people. Well, mostly lizard like aliens who want to eat humans, but no, she isn't gun-shy. And seeing the story through her eyes is a great lot of fun. The plot-twist with the eliminated memory could have felt contrived, but it doesn't, it actually allows for a more thorough built up of the overall story arc. But what blew me out of my socks was the story of Ren, the captain's daughter and how she fits into the big picture. This turn was pretty cool and from one moment to the next, it's not at all a sure thing who is villain and who is hero. That draws this trilogy apart from other sci-fi, where you can often find the western-kind of black and white characters. No, nothing is easy here, not for Devi and not for anyone else. And there are decisions to make that are hard and on shaky moral ground and I have to admit, I wouldn't know what to do, if I were Devi and her associates... As I said, the overall plot gained depth and the book leads towards a finale I can't wait to read.

Deviana's Leben ist sicher, doch auf Kosten ihres Gedächtnisses, das weitaus grössere Lücken aufweist, als sie realisiert. Sie spürt eine innere Leere und kommt schwer damit klar. Den Koch des Schiffes, dessen Namen sie sich nicht merken kann, kann sie nicht ausstehen, ihr wird bereits von seinem Anblick belästigt. Deviana ist weiterhin für die Sicherheit auf dem Raumschiff Glorious Fool zuständig und heuert den Ersatz für ihren getteten Kollegen an. Dieser Ersatz, Rashid, zeigt auffälliges Interesse an der Tochter des Kapitäns, ist sonst nur an Geld interessiert. Während des kurzen Aufenthaltes auf einem unwirtlichen Planeten hat Devi unersessert beunruhigende Tagtrüme, die ihr von Ren geschickt werden, in denen sie umgebracht wird. Seit Devi von einem infizierten Alien gebissen wurde, werden ihre Hände in Stresssituationen schwarz, was sie sich nicht erklären kann; es zeigt sich immer mehr, dass sie mit einem Virus infiziert wurde. Die Geschichte geht nahtlos weiter, ist eindringlich und gut. Sie besteht zu einem grossen Teil aus Kämpfen und Flucht vor Menschen und verschiedenen feindlichen Aliens, quer durch die Galaxy. Aus Freunden werden Feinde und umgekehrt und alles aus guten Gründen. Die Anziehung zu Rupert hat sich in Ablehnung gewandelt, sein Verrat ist zu gross - also keine Romanze mehr.
