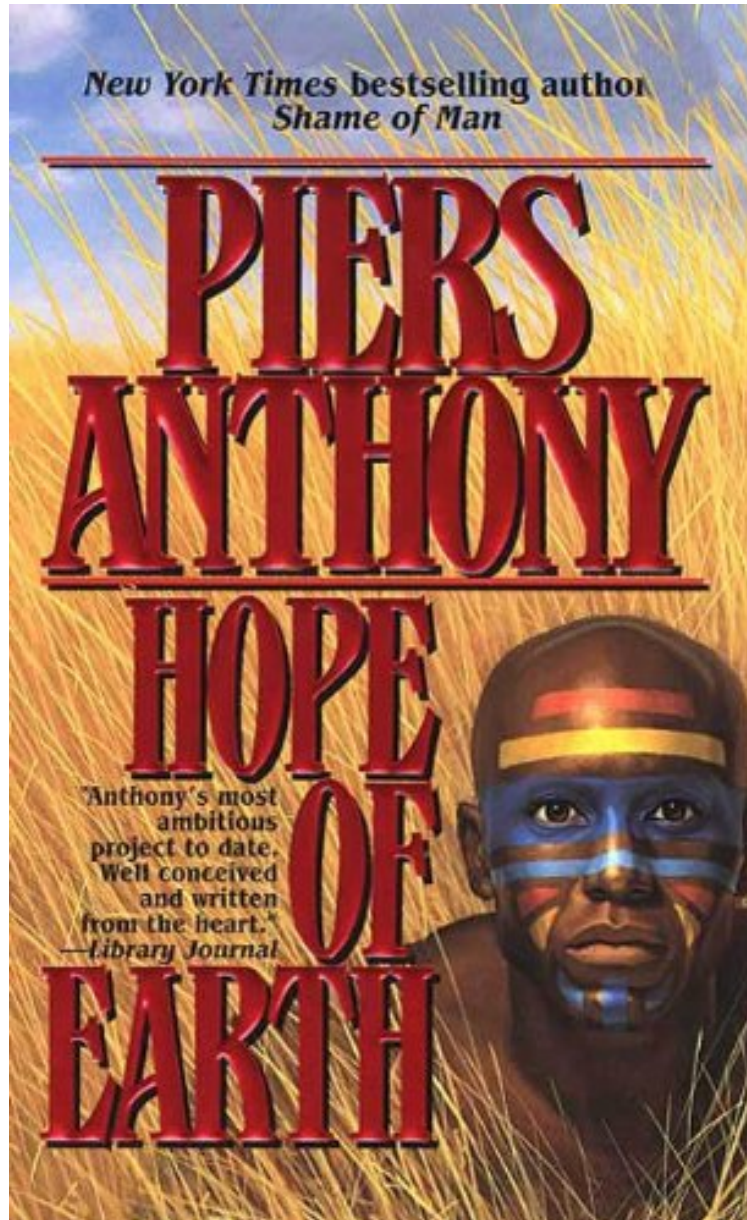

He doesn't focus solely on Western/Anglo cultures like other historical novels tend to do and he admits that sometimes, when women run things, they are wiser than men. He brings the more obscure and less discussed cultures to readers who probably didn't get exposed to them in school. I started the series by reading HOPE first and I'm glad I did.
