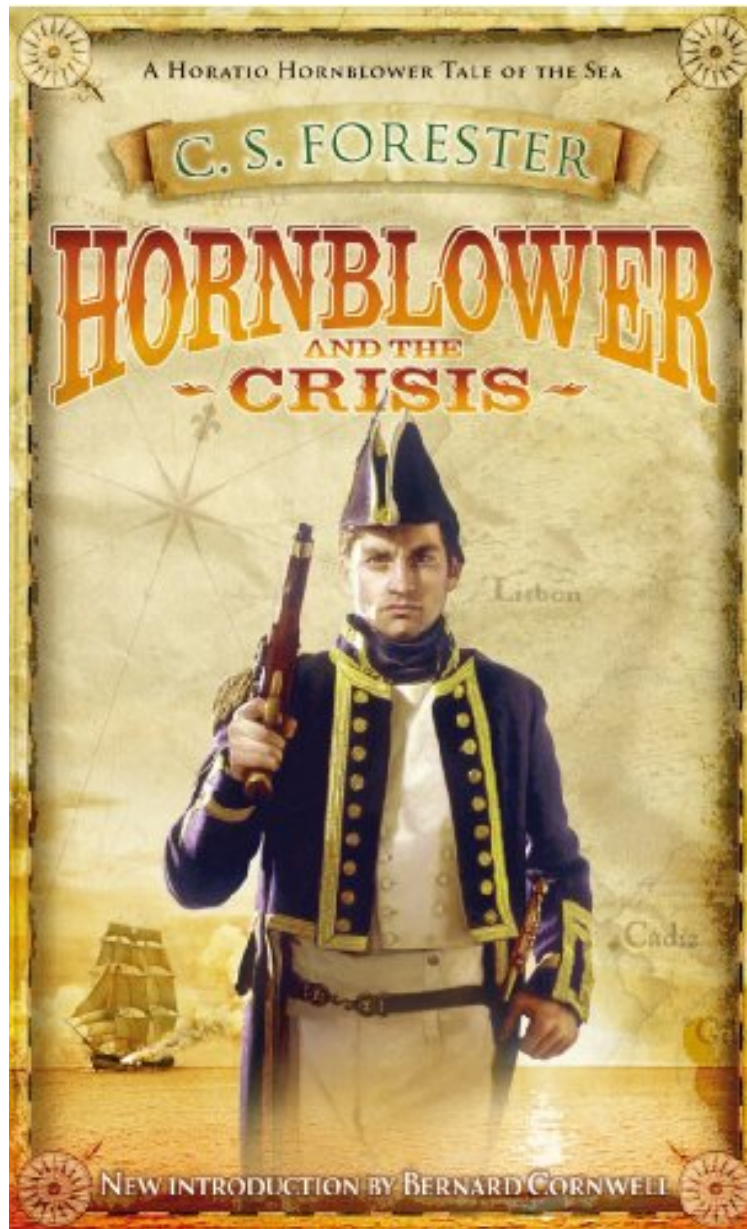

At the point the story ends Hornblower is faced with a decision: does he go to spy for his country? After that there are only a few short notes as to how the story would play out and experienced Hornblower readers will be able to guess at much more.Personally - I would like it if (fan fiction style) a writer like Bernard Cornwell would take it upon themselves to use Forester's notes and finish the thing. That would be a book worth reading. (and it's not unprecedented, I think there are crime writers - Desmond Bagley? - who have successfully had that treatment)As a bonus there are two short stories in this volume too: one goes back to Hornblower's time as a Lieutenant, one long after he has reached the rank of Admiral and retired.
