all books rely heavily on each other. They really aren't standalone-novels and you cannot read them out of order or separately - and one can't review them without spoiling what happened in the book[s] before. So if you haven't read the first book, "Full Blooded" yet, you should stop reading here and start at the beginning [which you shouldn't miss anyway].

**Synopsis** [by Goodreads.com] It hasn't been the best week for Jessica McClain. Her mate has been kidnapped by a Goddess hell-bent on revenge --- but Jessica is playing for keeps. Because she's the only female werewolf in town...it comes with its own set of rules...and powers. Aided by two vamps, two loyal Pack members, and one very reluctant human, Jessica must rescue her man while coming to terms with what being a wolf really means.

**[...]Review** The last book ended with Jessica's mate Rourke being in the hands of the Goddess Selene and Jessica on the verge of a rescuing mission together with her brother and Danny, another werewolf of her father's pack. Other than in the last installment, where Jessica and the reader were thrown right into the middle of everything, this time there are about 50 pages or so about the preparation of the journey, about what kind of being Jessica probably is or rather, what the Lycan she turns into is supposed to do according to an old prophecy. In any other book that could have come across as info-dump, but I was just as curious as Jessica and her family and friends are, to learn about everything that concerns her superhuman being. So instead of being annoyed that the action did not start right away, I could have read on forever about prophecies and mythical creatures and their jobs according to fate. Well, but as I expected it to be, the moment the action started, there was no more pause. The book in its core is the description of a road-trip with a lot of very dangerous [and entertaining] obstacles and fiends as roadblocks and enough talk to get to know more about some characters, gain more knowledge of the superhuman creatures besides the weres, demons and vampires and last not least learn a lot about Jessica's rather vast powers. That she is forced to take the annoying cop Ray with her on said journey [it's this or have him killed for the knowledge of the werewolves he unwittingly gathered in the last book] makes for funny scenes and these, along with Danny's silly jokes, lighten the mood a bit. Because the series definitely gets darker - there is not only the uncertainty if all [or any of them] will make it out alive and if they get Rourke back. There is also an overall arc developing in the background: her father has to travel to the south and deal with the other pack of North America and there are a lot of hints at impending doom. Uproar in the superhuman world, war lingering in the near future and on a very personal level, Jessica knows that the independent life she fought so hard for, has officially ended the moment the other supes got to know about the prophecy and her role in it. I liked it that Jessica on the one hand has these impressive and really immense powers, but on the other hand is bound by her feeling of justice and compassion, even for beings that piss her totally off. At the same time she is no saint and is more than a bit frustrated by her lack of necessary knowledge, since she was always regarded as essentially being a weak human and was not really let in on all the important bits and pieces when you are part of that world herself. Besides her and the other, very consistent and yet growing, characters, I love the world-building, the explanation how weres and their magic work, and the captivating overall story of Jessica and the prophecy. As with the first book, the mission at hand is completed, but there is cliffhanger as a pointer for the following adventure in the next installment, "Cold Blooded".

I read the 310 pages in less than a day and will continue with the next book immediately after finishing this review. I just read at Goodreads that the forth book [Red Blooded] is due for publication in 2014. The wait will be hard, since this is one of the best new UF series I have read in a long time.

Nachdem Jessica am Ende des letzten Buches knapp mit ihrem Leben davongekommen ist und ihr neu entdeckter Gefhrte, Werkatze Colin Rourke, von der bsartigen Gttin Selene entfhrt worden ist, macht sie sich zu seiner Rettung auf. Untersttzt wird sie dabei von zwei Vampiren, die ihr die Vampirknigin Eudoxia zur Verfugung gestellt hat, ausserdem von ihrem Zwillingsbruder Tyler und dessen Freund Danny. Dummerweise bekommt der lstige Polizist Ray das Ganze mit, so dass sie ihn kurzerhand ebenfalls mitnimmt. Wie es aussieht, hat die ganze paranormale Welt die Wandlung von Jessica mitbekommen und alle befurchten das Schlimmste fr ihre jeweilige Spezies. So helfen die Dmonen der Unterwelt Selene im Kampf gegen die Werwlf, die auf dieser Reise erstaunliche Eigenschaften entwickelt. Die Geschichte spuhlt sich rasant ab, springt von einer tdlicher Gefahr zur nchsten. Und die extrem selbstbewusste Jessica meistert alles mit Bravour und rettet ihre Gefhrten (meist) dank ihrer Fhigkeiten. Wir lernen innert wenigen Tagen jede Menge an paranormalen Wesen kennen. Zuviel fr mich, es geht auf Kosten der Entwicklung einer Geschichte, es fehlen die Hintergrnde, die Erklrungen, die wirklichen Gefhle. Dass die unter Bedrohungen durch Werwlf aufgewachsene Jessica, damals noch Mensch, so wenig Vorsicht und Voraussicht walten lsst, das kann ich nicht nachvollziehen. Der Funken zu Rourke sprang fr mich zu schnell, eine so nahe Beziehung ohne Beziehungsaufbau wirkt unecht. Dass sie Ray auf eine tdliche Mission mitnimmt, widerspricht jeglicher Logik und hat wohl mit seiner zuknftigen Rolle zu tun. Das erste Buch hat mich berzeugt, ich hoffe das nchste zeigt wieder etwas mehr Hintergrnde.
