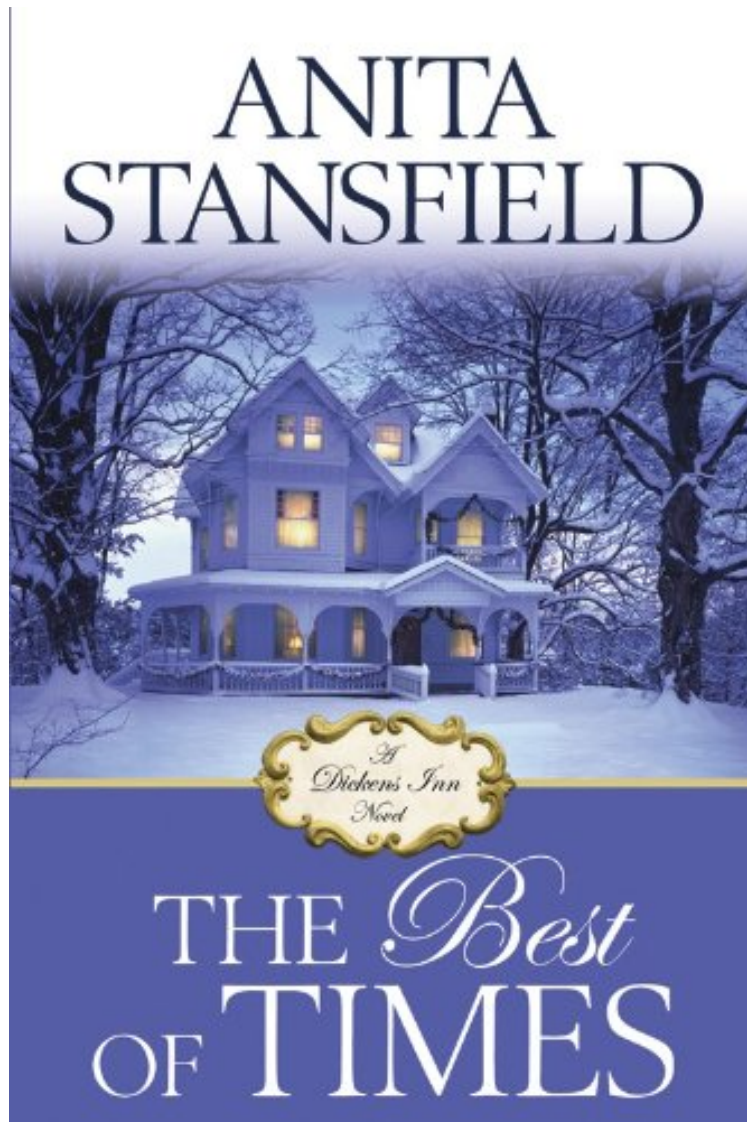

She used to flesh out situations in so much detail that I used to feel I was part of it. She says Jackson has to sleep on concrete floor and gets bad food. He is being tortured and wishes he could die. Why? I don't get it. I don't feel it. No, describing torture is not my idea of a good read, either, but I don't get why he is feeling so low. No detail, no empathy. I wish I could empathize more with the struggles the characters are supposed to suffer. We hear about them repeatedly in summary, but we don't get to feel them. That's a pity. I like reading clean novels, and here, Ms Stansfield is impeccable. Thank you. 3 stars for a nice, clean, entertaining novel.
