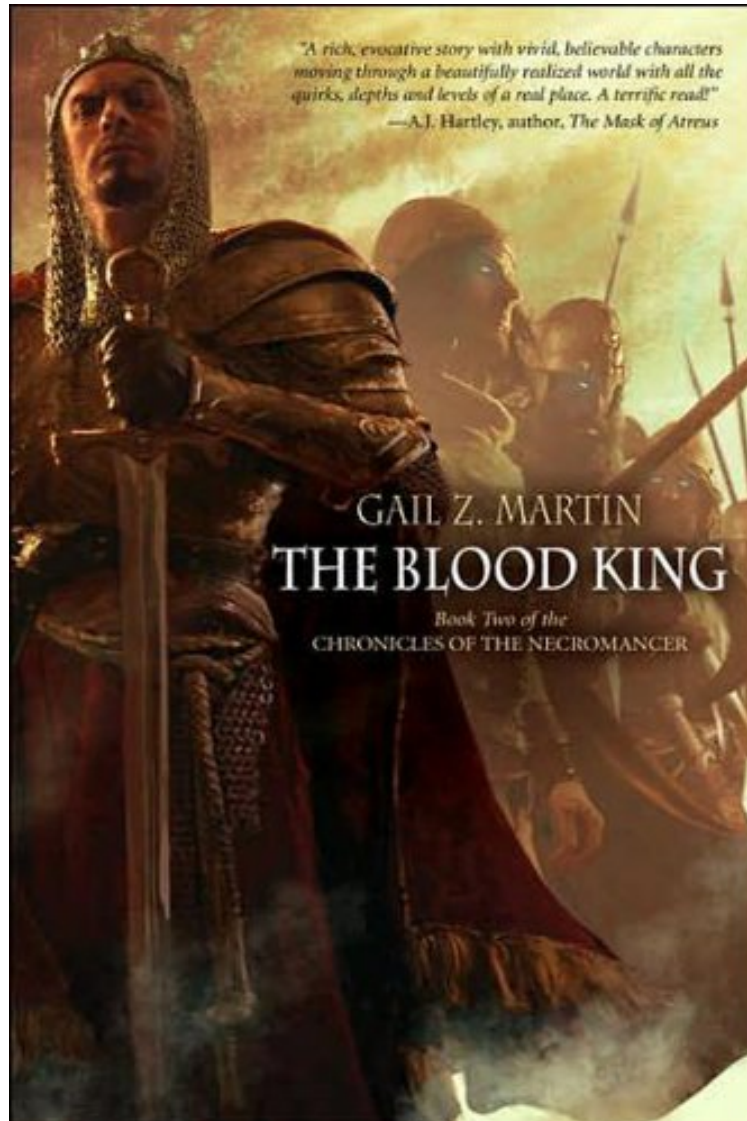

Just imagine every training montage and moment of quiet characterization from any movie you have ever seen, then string all of

those scenes together and play the result about ten times in a row, with the sound turned of. The result will be a good approximation of what reading the first half of *The Blood King* feels like. Only in the second half the pace picks up again, and is kept more or less up to the climax. But at least for me, reaching that part of the story was a chore. Sprachlich gesehen lt, selbst fr einen nicht native-speaker die Geschichte allerdings zu wnschen brig. Zu viele Versatzstcke langweilen den Leser ebenso wie hufig gleicher Satzbau. "Tris sagte..." "Kiara sagte..." Die an sich gut gewhlten Charaktere gewinnen ihre Tiefe leider nicht durch immer wiederholte Beschreibungen, sondern ausschlielich durch ihre Handlungen.
