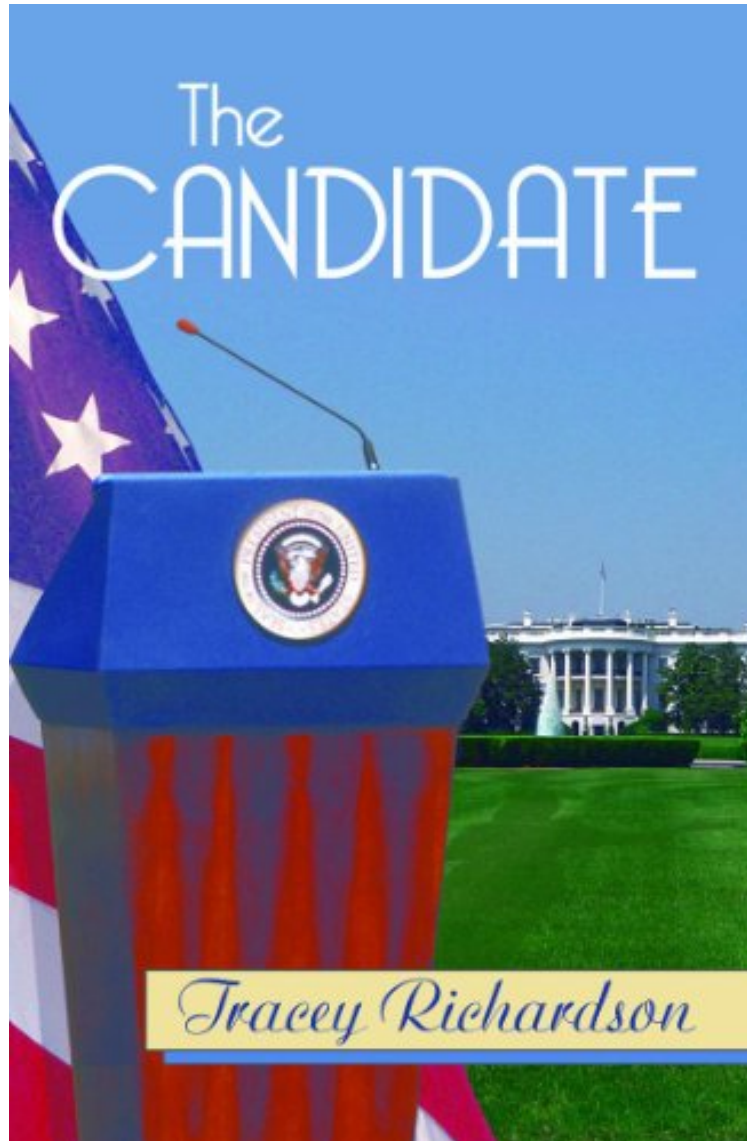

Unfortunately, the story was not very entertaining for me and I was a bit disappointed about the depiction of the main characters (the candidate and the bodyguard). You don't get to know them very well.
