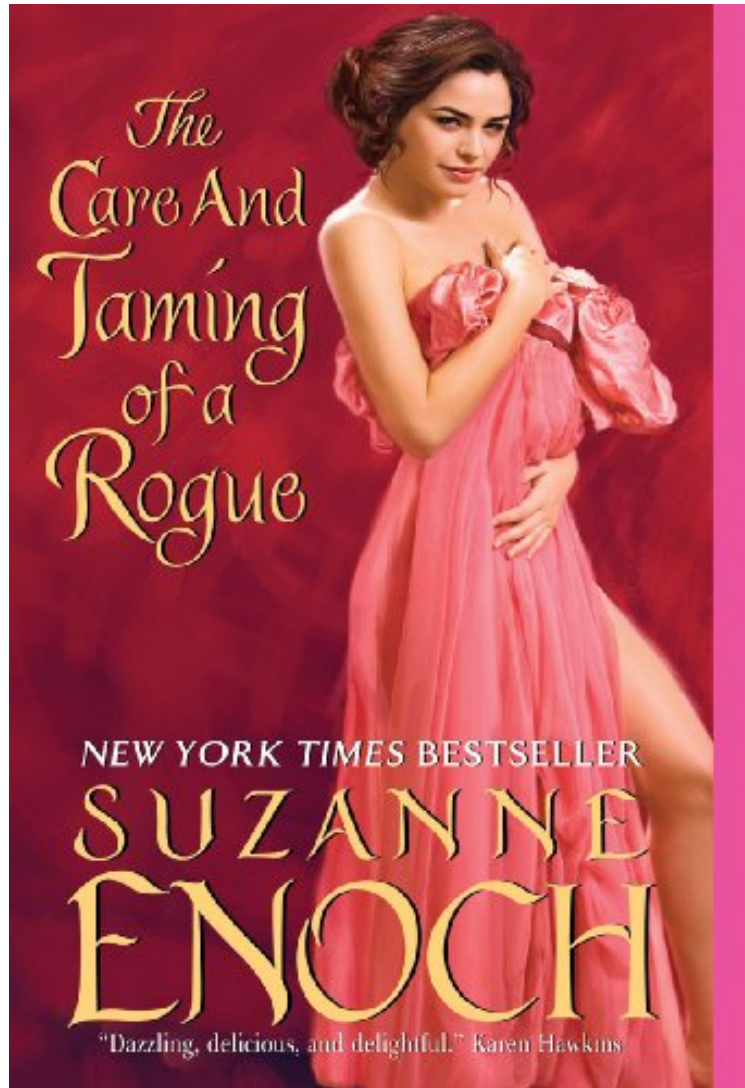

Phillipa Eddison. She's a bluestocking with no beaux but finds that Bennett Wolfe is taking an interest in her. However the fearless adventurer is rather out of place in society's drawing rooms. He doesn't entirely know how to behave and when he begins to court Phillipa he doesn't always get it right. But how can a stay-at-home avid reader and an adventurer with wanderlust ever make a good pairing? That final question is one of the problems with this book, in that I didn't feel that it was convincingly solved. There were other problems with the book, no less the rather odd name of the hero which sounded very un-British to me. The historical setting didn't feel very accurate and although there were some nods to some contemporary events (such as the Rosetta Stone), I didn't feel that the book sat all that well in its time period. The romance was sweet and believable but I found it hard to believe that Phillipa had been so overlooked previously when she came across as a very nice young lady. Bennett (that odd name again!) was a rather brash and uncouth character but I liked him, if not his propensity to violence. The subplot of some missing journals didn't work very well for this reader but I did find it a reasonable read overall.
