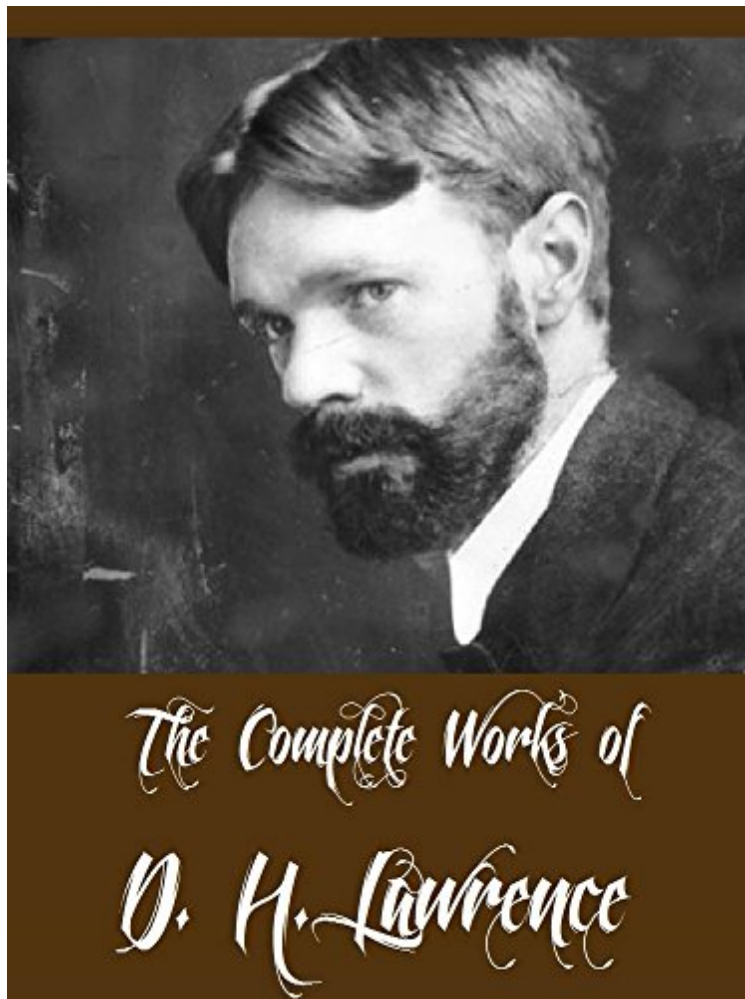

Lawrence is a great writer unless you get to read his complete works in one take! No joking, it is one of those cases where a fragmental piece of knowledge probably serves you better than the whole... I remember absolutely loving sons and lovers when I read it some years ago. I remember being taken aback by the audacity of this man, producing a novel like lady chatterley in that time, and in protestant etiquette watch-your-manners act-according-to-your-class England of the time as well. Not to mention the amazing fights with my socialist friends considering the book 100% bourgeois (as in the rich lady needs a working man to satisfy her bodily needs, which pretty much depicts the working man as an animal etc) without of course having read it first. There is some really good writing here, and some very innovative views into the structure, viewpoint, sincerity of the novel. But reading three one after the other (I think it was sons and lovers, the rainbow and women in love in one long tormenting take) I couldn't help noticing the inevitable repetition of the same themes, the same manierisms, the same issues in his writing! Great issues by the way, but some of the books are like slightly altered versions of the book before them, which in itself evolved from some other one you already read etc. So, my advice: definately buy, but take your time with it (unless you are writing your thesis on the man, in which case the pain will serve you right!) Pick one, then find another with a description very different or take a break with some other author before you go on with D.H. It will help you appreciate him a lot more like that and save you from the otherwise inevitable depression of following in lots and lots of detail the thoughts and feelings of lots and lots of characters who ALWAYS fell themselves torn between lots and lots of contradicting wishes and needs and suffer lots and lots of mood changes...which, yeah, can be a little bit too much of a good thing! (PS I love you DH, just trying to help the process of initiation! :-))
